Our Worthy 4th Degree Master, Mike Morrison, addressed us at our officers meeting on Nov. 10th, regarding the Exemplification. It goes without saying that our Assembly will be in the spotlight for this event. We will have brother Knights from throughout San Antonio and the surrounding areas in attendance, we are estimating 250-300 in attendance. We have many good ideas from our officers that we are looking at, including providing a cash bar at the banquet, raffles and other plans for the ladies in attendance. Incidentally - many thanks to Mary Montemayor, Jackie Valus, Lina Ramirez and Aileen Corbisiero, these ladies met with us and the Worthy Master and are developing some activities for our visiting ladies.

A rough schedule of the day's activities is as follows:

- Exemplification Team / Master Arrives at 9:00 am
- Registration Starts at 12:30-1:00 pm
- Exemplification starts at 2:00 pm
- Exemplification ends at 4:00 pm
- Ready for Mass 4:15 - 5:00 pm
- Attend Mass at our Church (Turnout) -5:00 - 6:00 pm
- Banquet in Banquet Hall (start) 6:30 or 7:00 pm

We will need our members help during all the activities.

The Attire will be tux and bring your regalia, the master will need help of possibly some men in regalia. We will use our Color Corp, hope we can get our flag by then, under the direction of the Worthy Marshal. Now is the time to start talking to our brothers in the 3rd Degree to get their 4th Degree. What do you need to be a 4th Degree Knight? You must be a 3rd Degree Knight and a Knight for at least six months. What is the cost? The cost for the exemplification is \$ 70.00, includes candidate's banquet meal and the cost for an additional banquet meal, i.e., wife, and is \$ 25.00. The candidate must wear a tux, social baldric will be provided. I would like to hear from all of you who would like to participate in this event, we can start a list and draw from that list to man the various committees that we will need!
